Open Access Policy for International Journal of Crowd Science

1. Open access policy

According to the major definitions of open access in scientific literature (namely the Budapest, Berlin, and Bethesda Declarations), Tsinghua University Press (TUP, the owner of the journal) defines Open Access by using the following conditions:

- (1) Peer-reviewed literature is freely available without subscription or price barriers.
- (2) Article is immediately released in open access format (no embargo period), and is free to be distributed and achieved.
- (3) Published material can be re-used without obtaining permission as long as a correct citation to the original publication is given.

2. Article Processing charge (APC)

International Journal of Crowd Science is a subsidized open access journal where TUP pays for the publishing costs incurred by the journal. Authors do not have to pay any Article Processing Charge or Open Access Publication.
